Horne, Hardee	-----	-- 1923	(Son of Benajah and Elizabeth Tarver Horne, Hardee, at the age of 14, ran away to "join the Cavalry". Was present at the capture of Plymouth and would have been present at Appomattox but for being "on the wrong side of the river." Father of Dr. Herman H. Horne, of New York University.)
Horne, Ida C. Harrell	-----	--- 1931	(Wife of Hardee Horne. Daughter of Dr. Wm. B. Harrell, 3rd pastor of Liberty Church, and Ann Battle Harrell who traced her lineage from two ancient Kings, Ida Harrell Horne, poet and author in her own right, was the mother of Dr. Herman H. Horne whose philosophical works have been translated into 27 foreign languages. Ida C. H. Horne's books are: "Simple Southern Songs" and "Songs of Sentiment," (both volumes of verse, the latter published in 1917 by the Neale Pub. Co. New York) and a travel book, "Romantic Rambles," Pub. in 1926 & describing a year spent in Europe)
Horne, Samuel Ruffin	-----	June 8, 1918	(Son of Benajah and Elizabeth Tarver Horne, Sam Horne with his brother Ashley, enlisted in the 53rd N. C. Regiment, serving as Lieutenant. Also like his brother Ashley, Sam Horne was interested in the cause of education, and gave largely of his personal means. With no great fortune, nevertheless he probably helped more boys and girls than any one except the late John Pullen of Raleigh.
Horne, William Henry	July 25, 1879	Dec. 25, 1897	Son of Ashley and Cornelia Lee Horne.
Horne, William Henry	May 8, 1839	Oct. 23, 1861	Son of Benajah & Elizabeth Horne 14th Reg. N. C. Vol. (One of six brothers to serve the South; died from effects of war.)
Jones, Bettie J. Dodd	Jan. 18, 1843	Jan. 4, 1889	Wife of Wm. B. Jones. (Stone reads, "Bettie J. Dodd, wife of Wm. B. Jones.")
Lunceford, Emily	May 1, 1811	June 14, 1888	Wife of David Lunceford. (Sister of Benajah Horne and daughter of Henry and Charlotte Gulley Horne. Henry Horne, father of Benajah and Emily Horne Lunceford, held land under the British Crown, the original Deed being in the possession of Dr, Herman H. Horne, of Leonia, New Jersey.
McCullers, Eugene Herbert, M.D.	-----	Aug. 1938	(Fourth son of Wm. Henry and Mary Jones McCullers. Dr. McCullers was one of the earliest Orthopedic practitioners in America. The above are the parents of Nellie Melba McC who sends this survey)
