Mr. Tomlison having died. "the widow Tomlison" as she is still g generally called in Clayton, married secondly John M. White and became the mother of Dr. John E. White, famous Baptist preacher, and of Bruce White, now of Wake Forest.) Since writing the paragraph Saturday morning in reference to W. C. Tomlison and his burial at Liberty Grove. I found late Sat. aftermoon that the body of Mr. Tomlison had been removed to the old Town Cemetery. I have not reached that place in the Town Cemeteryyet due to windy and rainy weather. Was forced to stop and work on interviews. Am sending this as I do not believe I shall ever identify the two unmarked graves by Ann Ellington. Th McC. Jones Ellington and Stallings families were kin but I cannot think of anyone left who knows. Nor can I verify the Martha Layton grave other than what my uncle, E.B. McC. remembers. The name is very familiar. "Martha Layton." and I know she lived with my grandmother. But that's all. The lst wife of Wm. Henry McCullers, Sr. was Selina Hinton. She is said to be buried at the Bill Banks place near the jonnie Stallings farm. I have never been there but will go. Martha might
